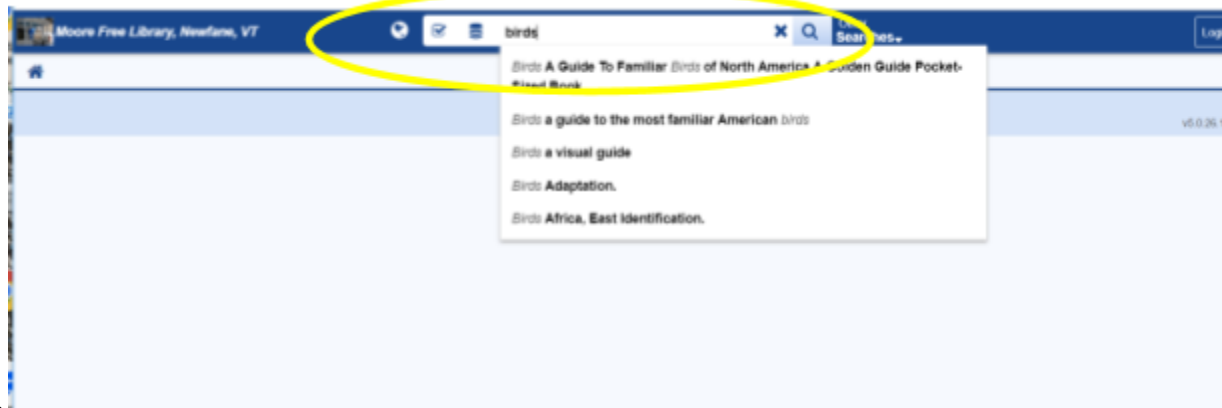


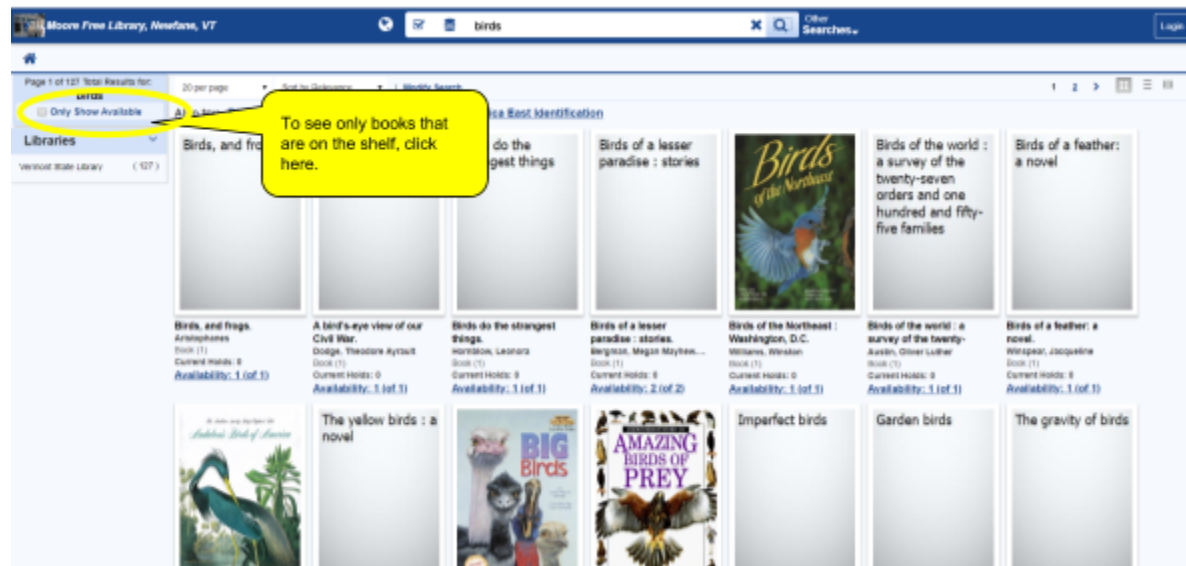
How to Search for Books/DVDs/Audiobooks at Moore Free Library

From the Moore Free Library web site (www.moorefreelibrary.org), go to the search bar, and enter the **title**, **author**, or **descriptive keywords**. As you type some suggested titles may come up.

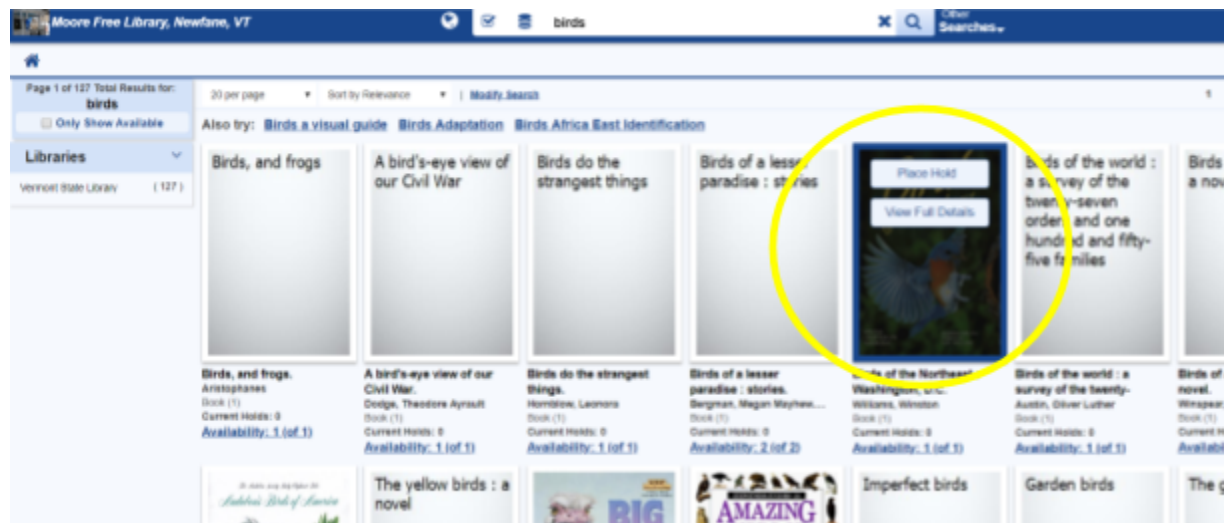
You can select one of those titles by clicking on it with the mouse, or just type your work (like “birds”) and either click on the magnifying glass or hit enter on the keyboard.



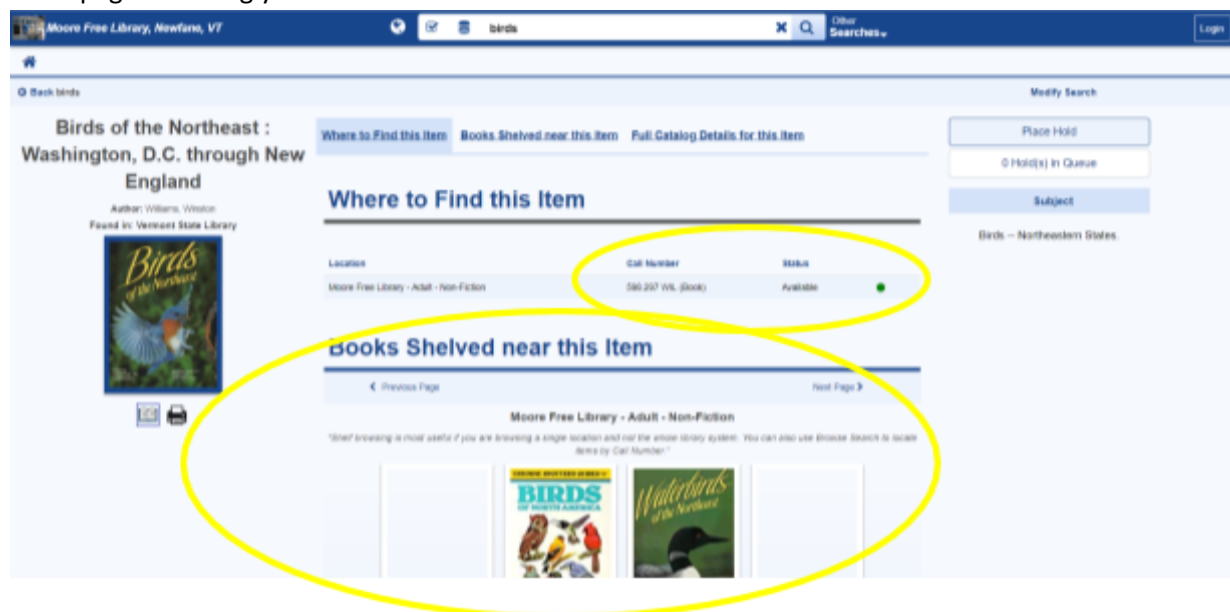
The results page looks like this:



To find out where the book is located, click on the image, or the gray box with the title, if there is no image. (No image just means that we don't have an image of the book cover, but we do have the book in our collection).



Clicking on the image from the results page will bring you to information about that book and similar ones:



The **Call Number** tells you where to find the book on the MFL shelves, and below that, you can see **other books** that are shelved near the book you're looking for. These are usually books by the same author or books on a similar topic that might be of interest to you.

If you need help finding books on the shelves, just ask a volunteer or library staff -- we'll be glad to help you find your items!
